



Every box contains 8 moulds for moulding clay or putty. The moulds represent the heads of various animals. Also there are many different colored paints with brushes for painting the articles after they are moulded. Then with each set comes a number of cards upon which the moulded objects can be mounted and hung up if desired. The work is most fascinating, and will doubtless interest many of the older members of the family as well as the kids.
