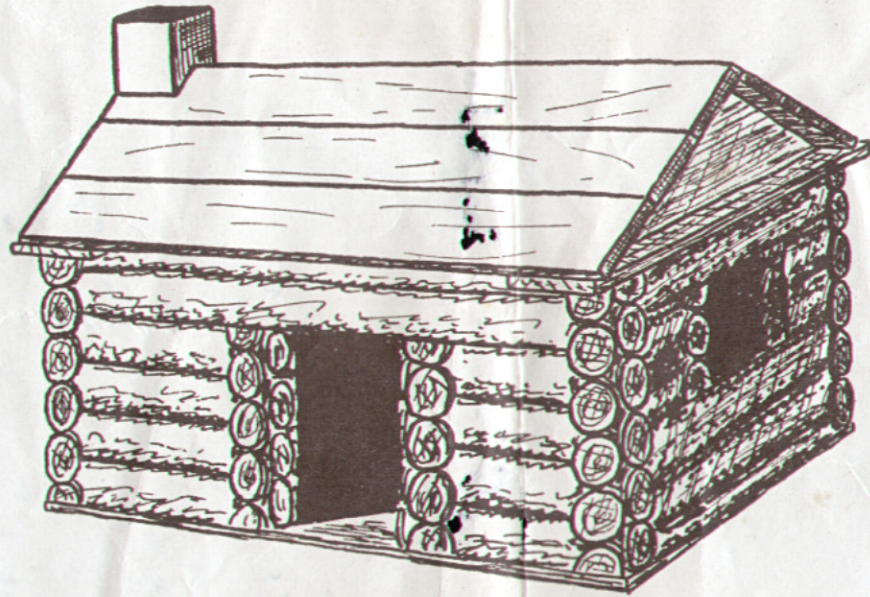


DANIEL BOONE

INSTRUCTIONS

Practically no instructions are needed. Simply look at the illustrations and proceed accordingly. Note that all models are started with the half-round logs. If you start with the six inch halves you finish with the five inch halves and vice-versa. Few illustrations are given. Just enough to get you started right. Use your own imagination.



One set builds a number of models; two sets permit more intricate designs. With several sets the number and completeness of models should be limited only by the imagination of the child using them.

Invaluable in schools for teaching and illustrating pioneer stories.

This model is patterned after hunting cabin used by Daniel Boone from 1760 to 1769.. Thus was founded Boone, N. C.

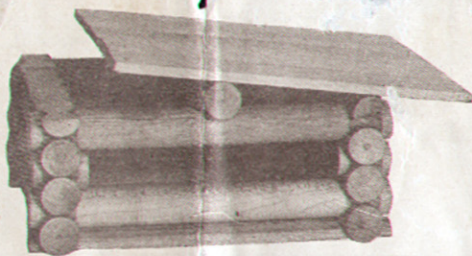

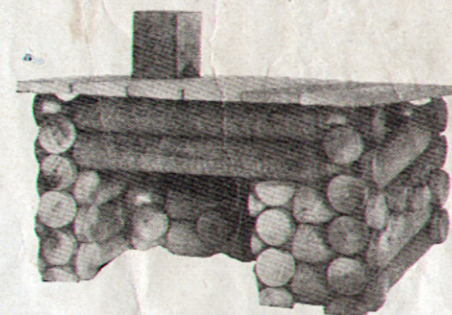

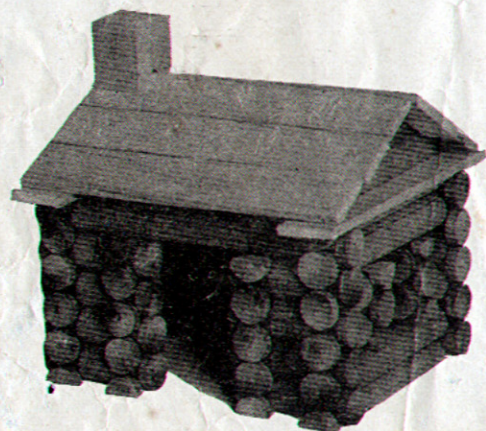

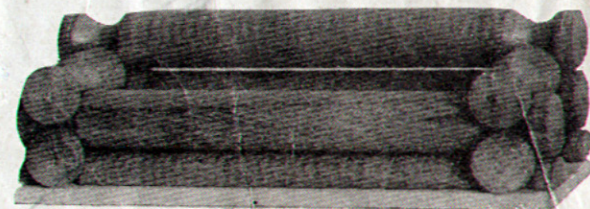

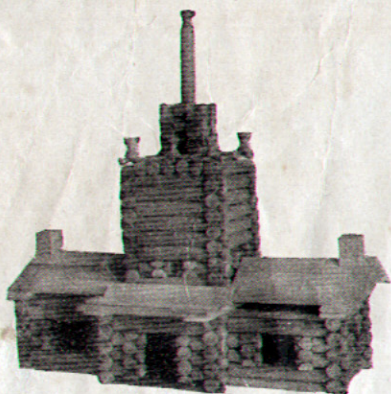

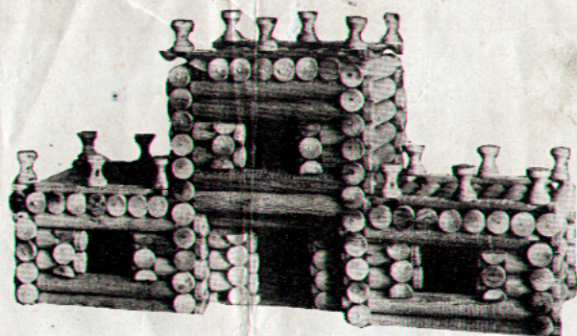

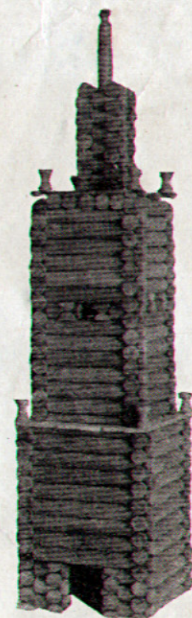

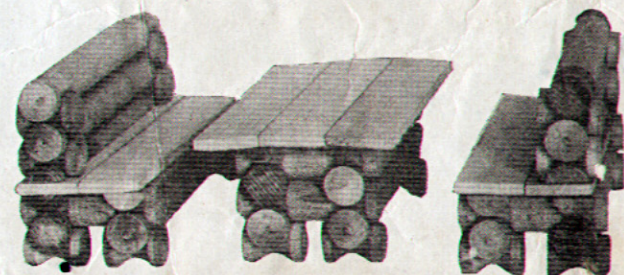
